- Font: Calibri, size 12, single spacing
- Max length: 400 words
- Title: ALL CAPS, max 150 characters
- Structure: Purpose, Methods, Results, Conclusions, Bibliography
- Written in English
- No images or graphics allowed
- Keywords: 3–6, lowercase, separated by commas
- References: max 5 at the end
